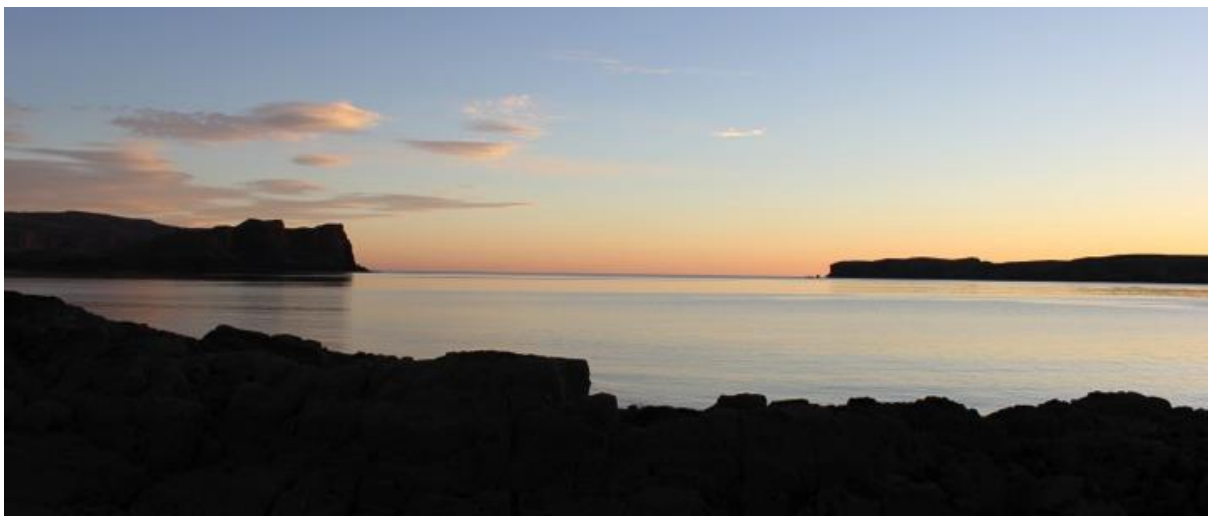

The Community Council (SCC) wants to keep you informed about what is happening in Struan and wants to know your views on matters affecting Struan. The best way of doing this is via our web site and Facebook page. The web site is our primary vehicle for communicating, and if you subscribe you will automatically receive emails about events, activities, publications etc. relevant to Struan. The web site also has information and minutes for the Struan Community Trust and other local groups. The Facebook page is used primarily for short term notices or to further alert you to something that is on the web site.

We also plan to use the web site to solicit your views on matters concerning Struan in order that we may better represent our community view to other communities, The Highland Council, Government and other concerns impacting on Struan. Where we use on-line surveys your input will always be anonymous unless we have asked for your permission in advance.

We will continue to post information on the Struan Noticeboard, but it is all but impossible for this to be immediately up-to-date, nor is it possible to post everything on the noticeboard. Where we are soliciting opinion, we will try and provide a facility to for hard copy of your input if you are unable or unwilling to do it on-line (at the school or some other local facility) but by far the best way will be to use the on-line facilities to know what is going on and to take part.
